Braden,

I spoke with Macon in our Legal Department to find out if Panera Bread had a firearms policy. He informed me that while we have no formal written policy regarding firearms in the bakery-cafes, that as a place of public gathering we do have a concern about the health and safety of our customers and associates. We also want our bakery-cafes to be warm, welcoming gathering places.

Therefore, should a situation arise with any customers carrying firearms, we ask that the GM explain the above and politely ask, for the comfort of our guests, that they keep their firearms outside our cafe. Of course, if the situation merits, they should not hesitate to contact the local police authorities.
